

PRIVACY POLICY

MANAGEMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

The user is informed of the legislation concerning marketing communication: the Law of 21 June 2014 on trust in the Digital Economy, the Law on Information Technology and Civil Liberties of 6 August 2004 and also the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR 2016/679).

PARTY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA

Personal data is collected on the website by the Communication service of the company SENTRYWAY, a limited company (SA) registered in the Regional Company Register of Lyon under the number 809 433 105 and with registered office at Les Carrés du parc – 10 rue des rosiéristes 69410 / Champagne au Mont d'Or France

PURPOSE OF COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

SENTRYWAY may treat all or part of the data in order to:

- respond to persons who have left their contact details
- ensure a sales response to companies who are interested in our solutions
- to improve site navigation (connection and utilisation data)

By submitting a form and checking the consent box on the form, the user grants their explicit agreement to have their personal data treated for the purpose of managing the commercial relationship.

DURATION OF RETENTION OF PERSONAL DATA

The data collected via the forms is retained for a period of 2 years from the date of submission of the form.

PRIVACY OF PERSONAL DATA

The personal data collected by the website <https://www.sentryway.com> can be treated by the company SENTRYWAY, its subsidiaries or its sub-contractors and will only be utilised according to the request explicitly made on the forms.

SENTRYWAY undertakes to take all necessary precautions to preserve the security of the information and in particular that it is not transferred, assigned to or marketed to third parties.

LOCATION OF STORAGE OR PERSONAL DATA

The servers where the website is hosted are located in France, within the European Union. SENTRYWAY undertakes not to carry out any transfer of personal data to a state which is not a member of the European Community or is recognised as “unsuitable” by the European Commission without informing the client beforehand.

SECURITY OF PERSONAL DATA

To ensure the security and privacy of Personal Data and Personal Medical Data, the website www.sentryway.com uses networks protected by standard mechanisms such as firewalls, pseudonymisation, encryption and passwords. When treating Personal Data, the website www.sentryway.com takes all reasonable measures to protect against any loss, misuse, unauthorised access, divulgation, alteration or destruction.

DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

RIGHT OF ACCESS, RECTIFICATION OR DELETION OF PERSONAL DATA

In adherence to the law on Information Technology and Civil Liberties of 6 January 1978 amended, and the European General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR 2016/679), the user has the following rights:

- right of access (article 15 GDPR)
- right of rectification (article 16 GDPR), update, and completeness of data
- right of blockage and deletion of User’s personal data (article 17 GDPR), when the data is inaccurate, incomplete, incorrect, out-of-date, or where its collection, use, communication or retention is prohibited.
- right to withdraw consent at any time (article 13-2c GDPR)
- right of restriction to the treatment of User’s data (article 18 GDPR)
- right of objection to the treatment of User’s data (article 21 GDPR)

- right of portability of data that the Users have provided, when the data is subjected to automated treatments based on their consent or on a contract (article 20 GDPR)
- right to define the fate of the User's data after their death and to choose whether www.sentryway.com should communicate (or not) their data to a third party that it will have previously designated
